• Sean Nguyen, President, reports that it is important to check in with your child and ask beyond "how are you." Elections occurred and Sean is SGA President. SGA





## 7:35pm Principal Report and Q&A: Dr. Ann Bonitatibus -

• Dr. Ann Bonitatibus, Principal, welcomes and thanks everyone again. Three prongs for opening. Make sure technology works, make sure to make personal connections and maintain academic rigor. Teachers are doing fantastic and pleased how much work the teachers have been doing. Wellness goals, I wanted to thank Sean for the video to bring awareness to our community due to the loss of James Huang. As we start 8th period, there will be an ability twice a month one block, to engage with each other and stay connected. We will be submitting our school improvement plan. FCPS is requiring a 4th goal around equity and responsiveness. Text books will be provided in a brown bag for all books. 250 signed up for SATs and short of that arrived on site yesterday. A good sense if have to come back to school. PSAT will be on October 29, 2020 due to covid circumstance it will be only for Juniors. We will reach out about if anyone needs transportation. Feel bad for not having back to school bash and homecoming so supportive of ideas of what TJHSST can do. No field trips or gathering of students. Not permitted to sign contracts right now and don't know what our operating status will be. Dr. Braband presented plans about some certain groups of students going back to school. So Dr. Bonitatibus has requested if some seniors for select labs will be able to come back prior to other students. Dr. Braband is examining the proposal and if he gives approval, TJ will see what the interest is. TJ is the pilot site for checking out streaming equipment. Teach kids who are in classroom and kids at home. Unhealthy levels of screen time. Having text books delivered and picked up will help. Find out how much time on screens and homework but give us another week or two to figure it out.

7:45pm <u>TJ Admissions Proposal</u> Discussion.

- Per Nick- Contact policy makers and share your feedback. Also share your feedback on your TJ experience, positive or negative. Superintendent's proposal is a goal for diversity but attached to the TJ budget. PTSA is encouraging everyone to write FCPS board emails and tell them thoughts and proposals. If you watch school board sessions, please share your experiences with school board.
- There was a question and answer session with Dr. Bonitatibus regarding the merit lottery system which included some suggestions and comments
- There will be a work session on October 8, 2020- school board does not have to vote operational change and not require a school board vote.



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- EC submitted the survey before the Merit Lottery was proposed. EC may do a survey on this proposal which was not done before.
- Principals opinion- kids will not suffer if have a 3.5 gpa. TJ is a school where kids come to thrive. Underselling faculty and underselling peer support and underselling child coming into the school. The kids can't be looked at as the less than student and not called the remedial student.
