Call Meeting to Order

- A quorum was determined to be present and the president called the meeting to order (@7:01).
- The president reminded the assembly of the meeting rules that were sent out in advance and highlighted a few of them:

Agenda Adoption

- The proposed agenda has been sent out and published on the website.
- The Third VP moved to approve the proposed agenda and was seconded by the Treasurer.
- The Third VP moved to limit debate on the agenda to ten minutes and was seconded by the Treasurer.
- By 98% votes in favor and 2% abstained, the motion to limit debate on the agenda to ten minutes passed.
- The president opened the floor for discussion of the proposed agenda.
- As there was no discussion, the president asked the assembly to vote for the main motion.
- With 96% votes in favor and 4% abstained, the proposed agenda was adopted.

 the meeting.
