Call Meeting to Order - Yvette Rivers

• A quorum was determined to be present and the president called the meeting to order (@7:00).

- The president reminded the assembly of the meeting rules that were sent out in advance and highlighted a few of them:

- The president reminded everyone how to use the cards to vote in the meeting.

Agenda Adoption - Yvette Rivers

- The proposed agenda is shown on the screen.
- Elaine moved to approve the proposed agenda and was seconded by Laura.
- No proposed discussion on the proposed agenda. With 100% votes in favor, the proposed agenda was adopted.

Approval of 1/12/23 GM Meeting Minutes - Yvette Rivers

- The draft minutes were sent out via email and have been available on the website. Since the minutes had been distributed in advance and there was no objection, the minutes were not read aloud during the meeting.
- As there were no corrections to the 2023-1-12 TJ PTSA GM Meeting Minutes, the minutes were approved as presented.

Principal's Report - Dr. Ann Bonitatibus

- Wellness check
 - It's important to stay positive. Shout-out to Rachel and student representatives for raising student morale.
 - Student SEL Survey Data
 - 68% students have positive feelings about their social, emotional, motivational skills, 10% higher than average in FCPS high schools, with consistency across grade levels
 - 70% students feel positive about environments, 11% higher than average in FCPS high schools, 8% increase from last year, with consistency across grade levels
 - 49% students feel supported through relationships, 2% higher than FCPS average, 14% increase from last year. Efforts from school staff, student groups, and PTSA have all contributed to the increase
- Staff Engagement Survey Data
 - 81% staff stated they are engaged.
 - 93% staff stated their work is interesting.
 - 75% staff stated they are motivated to contribute more than what's expected of them
 - 76% staff engaged compared to 68% in 2019
- Thank you and celebrate these achievements.

SGA Report - Rushil Umaretiya

- Winter Bash has been a huge success with higher spending this year
- Successful talent show, great turnout
- SGA purchased \$3,000 worth of basketball tickets to provide free access to TJ students
- Our goal was to make the necessary expenditures to grow our community. The SGA budget is currently in a \$6,500 deficit.

- Christina: Do we have a J-day date set yet? Rushil: 5/30. Yvette: will include it in the PTSA newsletter

Treasurer's Report & Proposed Budget Revision - Nell Janardhan

- Exceeded revenue goals for the year over \$41,000 vs. \$37,900, therefore, we request budget revision
- Presented comparison between actuals and baseline budget by category
- We're proposing \$1,000 increase towards students' club support; raised revenue goal by \$3,100 to reflect by actuals; PTSA office by \$500 to reflect increased zoom webinars to allow for more than 100 registrants.
- Proposed revised budget has been distributed.
- On behalf of EC, Nell moved to adopt the revised budget. No discussions are requested. All approved. Motion has been adopted.

Nominating Committee Election: Yvette Rivers

- Yvette: The TJ PTSA will hold PTSA Officer elections during the May 25 the General Membership Meeting. And to make this happen, per our Bylaws, a Nominating Committee is required to compile and recommend a slate of officer candidates to present at the April General Membership meeting, which will be virtual on April 20th. Printed Directory Recommendation for 2023-2024: Yvette Rivers

- We are not proposing to vote on this today, but instead give notice of a vote during our next General Membership meeting in April regarding whether the PTSA should print the student directory next year.
- This is to give some background and share the Board's recommendation to members regarding printing the directory next school year.
- Traditionally, the TJHSST PTSA has provided a service to TJ families by producing a printed Student Directory that automatically includes all registered students in grades 9-12 unless their parent/guardian opts them out. The PTSA also offers an online and searchable version of this directory that includes all the same information as the Printed Directory, but in a different format.
- In the fall of every year, prior to printing the directory, parents/guardian who have not opted out are asked several times to login to verify data, update their contact information, and review/update their opt-out preferences.
- Pros of printed directory were presented.
- Cons of printed directory were presented.
- Board recommends NOT printing the student directory next ear and promoting online student directory instead. Members will have an opportunity to discuss and vote on the decision at the next membership meeting.
